LESSON 3: Jesus' Love Knows No Bounds

OBJECTIVE: To help children understand that Jesus' love for us is limitless and extends to everyone, regardless of their background or circumstances.

BIBLE PASSAGES:

LUKE 19:1-10




INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Begin by asking the children if they have ever felt left out or excluded.
- 2. Explain that Jesus' love is inclusive and reaches out to everyone, regardless of their situation.

LESSON:

- 1. Read aloud Luke 19:1-10, focusing on the story of Zacchaeus.
- 2. Discuss the passage using questions such as:
 - Why do you think Zacchaeus was surprised that Jesus noticed him?
 - Our How did Jesus show His love to Zacchaeus?
 - How can we show Jesus' love to others, even those who may be different from us?







ACTIVITY 1: "FRIENDSHIP CHAIN"

- 1. Provide each child with strips of colored paper or construction paper.
- 2. Ask the children to write the names of people they can show Jesus' love to on the strips.
- 3.Instruct them to create paper chains by linking the strips together.
- 4.Once completed, display the chains in the Sunday School room as a visual representation of Jesus' limitless love for all.

ACTIVITY 2: INCLUSION CHARADES

- 1. Ask the children to sit in a circle.
- 2. Begin by telling a story about a chain of friendship that grows as people show kindness and inclusion to one another.
- 3.Start the story by mentioning one person who did something kind for someone else in the group.
- 4. Then, invite another child to continue the story by adding another act of kindness and inclusion, mentioning a different person in the group.
- 5. Continue going around the circle, with each child adding to the story by mentioning an act of kindness and including a different person in the group.
- 6.Encourage the children to be creative and imaginative with their contributions, while keeping the focus on acts of kindness and inclusion.
- 7. As the story progresses, emphasize how the friendship chain grows and connects everyone in the group, demonstrating the power of inclusiveness and love.

ACTIVITY 3: ACTS OF KINDNESS CHALLENGE

- 1. Explain to the children that they will participate in an "Acts of Kindness Challenge."
- 2. Divide the children into small teams or pairs, depending on the group size.
- 3. Each team or pair will be given a list of kind acts or gestures they need to complete within a certain time frame, such as 15 or 30 minutes.
- 4. The acts of kindness can include things like smiling and saying hello to someone, offering help to a teacher or staff member, or picking up trash to keep the area clean.
- 5. Instruct the children to work together to complete as many acts of kindness as possible within the given time.
- 6. After the challenge, gather the children together and allow each team or pair to share the acts of kindness they performed.
- 7. Discuss the impact of these acts on others and how it made them feel to show kindness and inclusion.
- 8. Encourage the children to continue performing acts of kindness in their daily lives to promote inclusion and love.
