DREAM ADVENTURE! GOD EMBASSY

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OBJECTIVE:

To teach children that God has unique and purposeful dreams for each of them, and to encourage them to trust in God's plans and pursue their dreams with faith.

MEYHORY VERSE: JEREVHIAH 29:11

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

INTRODUCTION:

Begin by asking the children about their dreams and aspirations. Discuss the excitement and importance of having dreams and goals.

Explain that God has special plans for each of them.



BIBLE STORY:

Read the story of Joseph from Genesis 37:1-11. Highlight how God revealed Joseph's dreams and how they eventually came true. Discuss the lessons we can learn from Joseph's story, such as trusting in God's timing and faithfulness.

DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION:

Engage the children in a discussion about their dreams and how they can align them with God's plans. Encourage them to think about how their dreams can bring glory to God and serve others.

GAME 1:


GAME 3:

Close with a prayer, thanking God for His plans for each child and asking for His help in following their dreams.
