

## JESUS SEES & LOVES US GOD EMBASSY



### LESSON 1: Jesus' Eyes Are on Us

OBJECTIVE: To help children understand that Jesus sees and knows everything about them and loves them unconditionally.

## BIBLE PASSAGES:

PSALVY 139:1-6 & PSALVY 139:13-18



#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. Begin by asking the children if they have ever played hideand-seek and how it feels when someone finds them.
- 2. Explain that just like in the game, even when we think we're hiding, Jesus sees us because He knows everything about us.

#### **LESSON:**

- 1.Read aloud Psalm 139:1-6, emphasizing the idea that God knows everything about us.
- 2. Discuss the passage using questions such as:
  - How does it feel to know that Jesus sees everything about us?
  - Why is it comforting to know that Jesus knows everything about us?
  - How does it make you feel that Jesus loves you no matter what?





#### **ACTIVITY: "GUESS WHO JESUS SEES" GAME:**

- 1. Have the children sit in a circle.
- 2.Explain that you will give each child a turn to be "Jesus" for a moment.
- 3.Instruct the child who is playing Jesus to close their eyes and count to ten silently while the other children quietly choose one person in the circle to be the "hidden object."
- 4.Once Jesus finishes counting, the chosen person becomes the "hidden object" and must keep a straight face.
- 5. The child playing Jesus opens their eyes and scans the circle, making eye contact with each person as they go around.
- 6. Jesus points to someone they think might be the "hidden object" and asks, "Jesus sees you, are you the hidden object?"
- 7. The person responds with a simple "Yes" or "No."
- 8.If Jesus guesses correctly, the hidden object becomes the new Jesus for the next round. If Jesus guesses incorrectly, they get another chance until they find the hidden object.
- 9. Repeat the game with different children taking turns as Jesus.

The purpose of this activity is to reinforce the idea that Jesus sees and knows us even when we think we are hiding. It also adds an element of fun and engagement to the lesson.
